

1. RULES AND REGULATIONS

Starship Personal Play is governed by the Rules and Regulations Respecting Bingo Games of the British Columbia Lottery Corporation (BCLC) which include limitations of liability and are available from BCLC upon request.

2. ISSUANCE OF BINGO CARDS

To participate in a Starship Personal Play bingo game, a person pays the authorized bingo service provider an amount that is credited to an electronic bingo account for a player. Upon such payment the player will be asked to enter an individual password after which the player will receive an electronic bingo slip. The player may then log onto an electronic bingo machine (which is commonly known as a player terminal) to play Starship Personal Play by entering such player's password.

The electronic bingo slip issued to the player will show the date and time, account number, credit balance, a control number and other relevant data.

The holder of the electronic bingo slip may add to the amount in the electronic bingo account or receive a portion or the balance of any cash remaining in an electronic bingo account by presenting the electronic bingo slip to the bingo service provider and entering the corresponding password whereupon the bingo service provider will add or refund amounts from the applicable electronic bingo account as requested by the holder of the electronic bingo slip.

3. PLAY

- a. Starship Personal Play is a bingo game that allows a player to play against the computer system.
- b. Starship Personal Play is available only at such bingo halls and at the times permitted by BCLC. BCLC may disable Starship Personal Play at any time.
- c. A player may of his own accord quit Starship Personal Play at any time. Subject to Section 3 b., a player may resume Starship Personal Play at any time provided that player has not closed his/her electronic bingo account. When a player resumes Starship Personal Play, play will continue from the point where the Starship Personal Play bingo game was disabled.
- d. The relevant instructions for Starship Personal Play will be illustrated on the computer screen of the electronic bingo machine.
- e. The player selects an unoccupied electronic bingo machine and enters on the computer screen the electronic bingo account number, as identified on the electronic bingo slip, then enters their password.
- f. The player then selects Personal Play on the computer screen and follows the instructions on the computer screen to select one of the following types of pattern bingo games: 1 Line Anyway, Block of 9, Parallel, Block of 4 or Bingo Plus.
- g. Once a pattern bingo game has been selected, the player proceeds to select the bingo card price of either \$0.15, \$0.25 or \$0.50 and the number of bingo cards to be played from 1 to a maximum of 20. Players can exchange bingo cards by following the instructions on the computer screen until such time as the player presses "Start"

- after which no such further exchanges may be made. The type of pattern bingo game the player has selected will be displayed on the computer screen.
- h. Once the "Start" button is pressed, the cost of the bingo card times the number of bingo cards selected will be deducted from the player's electronic bingo account.
 - i. The computer system displays each drawn bingo number by flashing the corresponding bingo number on each bingo card whose bingo number exactly matches the drawn bingo number.
 - j. A player touches the bingo card with the flashing bingo number to lock in that bingo number.
 - k. If the bingo pattern chosen by the player is exactly matched, a screen appears showing "BINGO!" followed by an instruction to "Touch Here". Upon touching that computer screen message, another message will appear stating "You Win" and the amount won, and the instruction to "Touch to Continue".
 - l. If the maximum predetermined number of bingo numbers are drawn and displayed and there has not been an exact match of the bingo pattern chosen by the player, a message will appear on the computer screen "GAME OVER TOUCH TO CONTINUE".

4. WINNING BINGO CARD

The bingo numbers on a winning bingo card must exactly match the bingo pattern chosen by the player prior to the start of the Starship Personal Play bingo game to win the applicable prize as set forth in Section 5 below or as announced by BCLC prior to that bingo game.

Winning bingo cards as a result of any draw for Starship Personal Play bingo games are determined as follows:

Winning Bingo Card	Consists of
1 Line Anyway	An exact match of all the bingo numbers on the same bingo card in a complete horizontal, vertical or diagonal line within the predetermined number of drawn bingo numbers.
Block of 9	An exact match of all the bingo numbers on the same bingo card within an area comprised of 9 squares formed by 3 squares by 3 squares within the predetermined number of drawn bingo numbers.
Parallel	An exact match of all the bingo numbers on the same bingo card in two complete horizontal or vertical lines within the predetermined number of drawn bingo numbers.
Block of 4	An exact match of all the bingo numbers on the same bingo card within an area comprised of 4 squares formed by 2 squares by 2 squares within the predetermined number of drawn bingo numbers.

Winning Bingo Card	Consists of
Bingo Plus	An exact match of all the bingo numbers on the same bingo card that form a cross or a "plus sign" formed by a horizontal line of 3 bingo numbers and a vertical line of 3 bingo numbers intersecting through the middle bingo number within the predetermined number of drawn bingo numbers.

5. WINNING BINGO CARD

The holder(s) of a valid bingo card which is a winning bingo card entitles its holder(s) to claim from BCLC, or if authorized by BCLC the bingo service provider, for each winning bingo card, a prize as set forth in Section 5 below or corresponding to the prize announced by BCLC prior to the start of that bingo game.

6. PRIZES

Prizes are determined as follows:

a. 1 Line Anyway:

7. PRIZE CLAIM

- a. Any prizes won by a player will be credited directly by the computer system to the player's electronic bingo account. The holder of the electronic bingo slip may claim

the prize by presenting the electronic bingo slip to the bingo service provider and entering the corresponding password where upon the amount received by the holder will be deducted from the applicable electronic bingo account.

- b. Prizes must be accepted as awarded and must be claimed from BCLC or where authorized by BCLC from the authorized bingo service provider who issued the winning bingo card and must be claimed within the period prescribed by BCLC.
